



Food import instructions

Trade in foodstuffs of animal origin:

Meat, poultry meat, fish, sprouts, dairy and other establishments, that handle products of animal origin generally require an EU approval. Irrespective of whether they operate only within the country or also within the within the EU. Establishments that handle products of animal origin, such as direct marketers, are also affected by the approval requirement,

are affected by the approval requirement. It is recommended that you contact your local inspection and/or licensing approval authority about the approval obligation. (Legal basis: Regulation (EC) 852/2002 and Regulation (EC) 853/2004)

Supplementary national requirements for the labeling of foods when they are placing on the market:

When placing foodstuffs on the market, the mandatory information according to the Regulation (EU) No. 1169/2011 must be declared in German. (Legal basis: Food Information Implementation Regulation - LMIDV).
